

# Equivalent Amounts

The Cannabis Act legalizes the possession of 30 grams of dried cannabis or the equivalent of 30 grams of dried cannabis in public. The Act creates seven “classes” of cannabis that each have an equivalency to 30 grams of dried cannabis.



Class of Cannabis	Quantity equivalent to 1 g of dried cannabis	Calculation	Equivalency Amount
Dried cannabis	1 g	$1 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	30 g of dried cannabis
Fresh cannabis	5 g	$5 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	150 g of fresh cannabis
Solids containing cannabis	15 g	$15 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	450 g of solids containing cannabis
Non-solids containing cannabis	70 g	$70 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	2,100 grams of non-solids containing cannabis
Cannabis solid concentrates	0.25 g	$0.25 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	7.5 g of cannabis solid concentrates
Cannabis non-solid concentrates	0.25 g	$0.25 \text{ g} \times 30 =$	7.5 g of cannabis non-solid concentrates
Cannabis plant seeds	1 seed	$1 \text{ seed} \times 30 =$	30 cannabis seeds
